She is a leading cyberpsychologist, inspiring keynote speaker, effective psychological/ transformational coach, and seasoned storyteller.

Dr Elaine Kasket is an HCPC-Registered Counselling Psychologist and an Associate Fellow of the British Psychological Society. In 2020, she was made an Honorary Professor of Psychology at the University of Wolverhampton for her body of work on life in the digital age. She is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts and a Senior Fellow of the Higher Education Academy.

Elaine is the author of *All the Ghosts in the Machine: The Digital Afterlife of Your Personal Data* (Robinson, 2019), in which she argues that what happens to our data when we die is the perfect lens for understanding the true power big tech wields over our information and our identities.

Her latest book is *REBOOT: Reclaiming Your Life in a Tech-Obsessed World* (Elliott & Thompson, 2023), in which Elaine explores how we can reclaim much of that power. At this juncture, with AI growing in strength and influence, Elaine explores how we can retain our fundamental humanity and nurture our relationships at every stage of life, and life more mindfully with and through technology.

Elaine is currently editing her first novel, which takes the experience of meeting a mysterious stranger online to a disturbing new level. She publishes <u>Reboot: Your Life on Tech</u>, a newsletter + podcast via Substack, and a creative storytelling podcast, <u>Wednesday's Ghost</u>. She tells tales onstage and online for The Moth, Mortified, Bodies of Stories and Perfect Liars Club, amongst others.

Elaine has featured at TEDx Oxford, York Festival of Ideas, Oxford Ideas Festival, and Congreso Futuro and is in high demand as a keynote speaker and trainer.
